The North Platte area experienced some great, economic results last year and our organization was involved with several projects. Projects either started or completed in 2011, that the Chamber & Development Corp was involved with totaled \$33 million in new investment and 74, new or retained jobs. The year also saw sales tax receipts above projections and the Quality Growth Fund will see more than a \$400,000 addition going into 2012.

We attended two industry recruiting trips, the American Wind Energy Association and the Data Center World shows and have been working active leads from both. We also attended the Nebraska Wind Energy Expo, which is aimed more towards land owners and developers. We partnered with the I-80 Coalition to market our region to distribution and logistics companies and have seen new interest from these industries.

Probably our greatest progress was seen in the information technology industry. Last year, Pinpoint Communications' brought new fiber optic lines to town for their HughesNet satellite downlink and datacenter. We also saw NebraskaLink bring new fiber optic lines to town. Allo Communications launched their plan to offer fiber to the home service in North Platte. These new technology capacities will be used to market North Platte to high technology companies in 2012.

North Platte also saw several projects along the "Ones" with several other projects recently announced. Over the next couple of years we will see some impressive changes along the "Ones."

Looking to 2012, I foresee another good year. The agricultural economy remains a bright spot which should help continued improvements in total retail sales. Our new Retail Development committee will also launch several new strategies aimed at increasing local retail sales. The construction jobs tied to projects that are pending will give a boost to the hospitality industry. As the national economy improves, I expect we will catch the attention of some retail chains not already in our market.

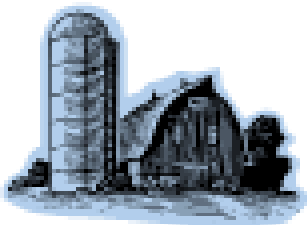

The Leadership Lincoln County Transportation Day began with an early morning tour at Union Pacific Railroad. Such an early hour means very little to an operation that runs 24 hours a day 7 days a week including holidays. The tour was provided by several managers at the UPRR. The bus we had for the day led us around Bailey Yard where we examined many of the operations that the different departments conduct every day always emphasizing the importance of “safety”.

The bus then took us across town to the Wal-Mart Distribution Center where we were fed a terrific lunch of Chicken Wraps. After lunch, our group was given a tour of the behind the scenes at the Distribution Center. Mark Oettinger and Rob Derbyshire divided our group in two and each manager took their group on an informative tour of the areas and work that their employees do every day. We certainly had to be on the lookout for some very busy people who didn’t have time to move around us, they needed a clear channel to get to and from where they needed to go to do their job properly. I was impressed with the cleanliness of the Center, not a speck of trash or dirt anywhere. Not much longer, we were on the bus again headed to the Lee Bird Field where we would spend the rest of the day. Four speakers came to provide presentations about other types of transportation. Jim Hawks, NP City Administrator, spoke about the City’s responsibilities and the type of transportation that is handled by the city as opposed to the state or the county. Gary Thayer and Roger Klasna, Nebraska Department of Roads, discussed the State’s responsibilities of highway and interstate roads and safety. The last speaker of the day was Mike Sharkey from the North Platte Airport Authority. He spoke on lots of issues that I am sure most people did not know like how important it is for the City of North Platte to even have an airport.

Transportation was the theme of the day, but safety is a common concern by all the speakers. Every organization is measured by how safe they are and this is a subject that is not taken lightly because, after all, there are people’s lives at stake. This day was filled with lots of information and at the end of the day, I left feeling very good about the leaders in our community who care so much about me and everyone else who lives in this great community.

WHAT ARE INCENTIVE FUNDS USED FOR?

The incentive funds are used as seed capital for business development and expansion in the Lincoln County Area. These private dollars allow the North Platte Area to remain competitive against other areas when recruiting new businesses. New companies must meet certain criteria (wage requirements, # of employees hired, amount of investment in community, etc.) before incentives will be awarded.



- Respond to Request for Proposals (RFP) from prospective companies looking to locate in the area.
- Maintain the primary website for individuals seeking Economic Development, and business information on North Platte and Lincoln County.
- Compile useful employment related data for area employers and prospective companies (i.e. Labor Availability Study, Wage and Benefits Survey, etc.).
- Conduct business retention and expansion visitations on companies within Lincoln County to both their local operations and corporate headquarters.
- Participate in Nebraska Department of Economic Development's and Nebraska Public Power District's recruitment visitations with corporate site consultants and companies in larger metropolitan areas 2-3 times per year.
